Tropical cyclone Freddy brought strong winds, mudslides, and landslides to 13 districts of Southern Malawi in March 2023. This resulted in a death toll of over 1,000 people, displacement of over 650,000 people, and destruction of property. 747 camps were set up to provide temporary shelter for those affected.

Life Ministry has had ongoing work in Mangochi district, which has the largest Muslim population. These humanitarian projects have mostly focused on the provision of safe drinking water and agriculture training. Cyclone Freddy relief efforts in phase one focused on this district, where 11 camps were set up to accommodate people displaced by the cyclone.





We distributed relief items which included: water buckets, bags of maize floor, cooking oil, soya pieces, plates, soap, body lotion)





We are building houses for some of the neediest families



We are teaching entrepreneurship skills such as local soap making so that people can start small-scale businesses which can help sustain their families.
